

Location & Transportation

King City is an unincorporated Canadian community in the township of King, Ontario, located north of Toronto. It is the largest community in King township, with 2,730 dwellings and a population of 8,396 as of the 2021 Canadian census. The rolling hills of the Oak Ridges Moraine are the most prominent visible geographical feature of King. The Holland Marsh, considered Ontario's "vegetable basket," straddles King Township and Bradford West Gwillimbury, King town. It is also known for its horse and cattle farms.

The Township of King is located between Toronto and Barrie, stretching from Bathurst Street to just east of Highway 50. King is accessible by Highways 400, 27, 9 and 11. Public transportation is provided by York Region Transit (bus service) and GO Transit (bus and train services). King City GO Station is the only train station in the township. York Region Transit's services are confined to the southeastern area and the GO bus serves the Nobleton and King City communities.
